Dear parents/carers

I am writing to update you on the arrangements during the forthcoming second day of planned strike action by the NEU (National Education Union) on **Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March.** As explained in my previous letter, the strike is happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over funding levels for schools, teacher recruitment and retention and teachers' pay, not because of any issues at our school. At the time of writing, the strike is set to go ahead but of course I will contact you if the situation changes.

Situations at different schools may vary, depending on the union membership at each school, so headteachers are making decisions based on their particular context. Here at Fearnhill, the arrangements will be as they were on 1<sup>st</sup> February, i.e.

- Years 7-10 School is closed to these year groups. Students can take the opportunity to work on homework and 'Super Curriculum' projects; details are on the website here <u>Fearnhill Flyers</u>
- Years 11-13 Students in these year groups should attend as normal. Some lessons will go ahead and if staff are not available students will be supervised by senior staff to complete quiet study. The Year 11 period 6 revision session from 3.00-3.50pm will not run.
- Parents of students who receive free school meals will receive a sign-up form to complete, so that we can prepare lunches to be collected from school if requested.
- There will be no breakfast, homework or after school clubs running on this day.
- School will be open as normal on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March.

I will write to you again with details of the plans for the remaining planned strike days, 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> March. I am sorry that you will have to make alternative arrangements for your child at short notice, and/or that they will experience disruption to their education. I understand that this situation may be frustrating, and ask that all members of our school community continue to treat each other with respect. Fearnhill remains committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our students and delivering high-quality teaching.

We are working closely with our staff union representatives to keep up to date with the situation, and I will inform you as soon as possible if arrangements change further.
