## **School Uniform Policy Reminder**

Thank you for your ongoing support with high standards of uniform at Fearnhill. The majority of students look smart at all times and are a credit to themselves and their community. Recently a small number of students have struggled to meet our requirements, so a reminder of our expectations is below.

Please note that as per our uniform policy, all uniform infringements will receive an L1 after school detention. If the issues are not resolved by the next day then the student will be placed in the supported study room or sent home until they are addressed.

If there are reasons why your child is unable to meet our uniform standards, please email the school prior to your child attending that day. Depending on the issue we will contact you to discuss further and offer support where appropriate.

Shops sell a wide range of uniform in their school sections, and therefore it is advisable to check Fearnhill's requirements prior to purchasing. Please contact us if you are unsure.

A reminder of expected standards of uniform can be found on our [website](#) and below.

- Trousers must be a polyester/polyester mix, they must NOT be denim, cotton or wool.
- Trousers must be plain black and a tailored fit. Trousers must NOT be skin tight, skinny fit or have a split in the trouser leg. No additions to the trousers such as decorated belts, buckles, lacing or labels are allowed.
- Shoes must be leather/leather look and you must be able to polish them. NO trainers, canvas shoes, plimsolls or boots are allowed.
- Socks must be black, grey or white
- No haircuts shorter than a Grade 2.
- No tramlines, designs, or extreme hairstyles.
- No unusual colouring, dyeing or highlighting.
- Hair should be tidy, of sensible length and safe for school type activities.
- Make-up should be minimal and discreet. No fake eyelashes or fake nails are permitted.
- Ear piercing – one stud earring per ear - No other facial or body piercings are permitted.
- No tattoos, temporary or permanent, are permitted.

- No ear expanders will be permitted.
- No jewellery other than that of religious significance is permitted. This must be removed for PE lessons on safety grounds.
- Skirts must be regulation length to the knee.
- All items of clothing MUST be clearly marked with the student name, so that lost property can be quickly returned to owners.
