Year 12 Geography Field Trip Investigating Regeneration in Stevenage, Tuesday 9th July 2024

Year 12 Geography students have recently completed their Regenerating Places Module. This module requires students to gain information on regeneration case studies. We will visit Stevenage Town Centre on Tuesday 9th July 2024 to investigate the £1 billion regeneration project happening there.

This field trip, and the work that follows it, is essential if students are to satisfy the exam specification. All geography students are expected to attend this trip. Students will gain the necessary field work skills that they will need in their upcoming NEA (Non Examined Assessment).

The students will need to arrive at School at the usual time and register in form on Tuesday morning. We will then alight the minibus and travel to Stevenage Town centre arriving for 9.30 am. The morning will include a question and answer session from a representative of the Stevenage Regeneration Scheme along with a walk and tour of the new and potential regeneration sites within Stevenage Town Centre. We will return to Fearnhill School by 1.00 in time for lunch.

Students must wear school uniform, comfortable school shoes and bring a coat. If the weather forecast is sunny and a few layers of warm clothes are better than one thick jumper. Students will need to bring a water bottle and a pen with them so they can stay hydrated and note down their results and inquiry findings.

As you have previously completed a global consent form for school trips and other off-site activities for your child, you will have already given your permission for them to participate in this trip, if this is not the case your child will be given a consent form for you to complete.
