We are a small secondary school - four form entry, with a total roll of over 600 students. We pride ourselves on being an inclusive, happy community – the Fearnhill Family. High quality teaching is our priority in every lesson, and we are proud to have knowledgeable teachers who are dedicated to helping our students succeed. Fearnhill is a great place to work because we value every member of the school community. Location

We are located on the outskirts of the picturesque town of Letchworth Garden City, just 30 minutes from London, and a five minute drive from the town centre. The town has with a varied and interesting history, represented in the names of our four houses. The school occupies purpose built buildings on a splendid hilltop site, in over 30 acres of land, with a beautiful view of the Hertfordshire countryside from the staff room. The buildings are designed to integrate the academic and pastoral aspects of school life and to place together subject areas that have interests in common. This has led to the development of a faculty structure that facilitates curriculum development.

Workload

We care about reducing teacher workload so that teachers have time for a life outside of work. For example, we have no written marking, no written reports, fewer data cycles, no formal lesson observations, no appraisal targets and centralised detentions to ensure teachers' time is not wasted.

Career Development

As a learning community, we prioritise high quality professional development for everyone working at the school. We take pride in our shared knowledge and understanding of teaching and learning and support our staff to develop their expertise and grow in confidence as professionals. We work closely with the North Herts Teaching Alliance and other providers, and all staff work within our appraisal system to ensure they are supported and given the right tools to succeed. Academic Success

As a school we exist to develop successful Fearnhill Students by removing barriers to progress, ensuring high achievement for all. Our exam results are also testament to our commitment to excellence, with our students making better progress than in most schools at GCSE. In our sixth form, our results are equally impressive, with 66% of all A levels graded A*-B. Our progress 8 score for the 2022/23 academic year is 0.27. In a recent study, where progress 8 was adjusted to account for demographic profiles, Fearnhill was placed top in Hertfordshire. As a result of our successes, Fearnhill is now oversubscribed for year 7 admissions and the number of students on roll at Fearnhill continues to rise. Behaviour

We recognise that poor behaviour makes teaching an unpleasant experience and prevents students from learning. We have high expectations of our students and effectively hold them to account when their behaviour falls below these standards. It is our aim that every student embodies the values of the Fearnhill Student: someone who is kind, confident, resilient and self-aware. We have recently undertaken a comprehensive review our school's behaviour policy. The new policy, which comes into effect in January 2025, sets clear boundaries for students with a tiered consequence system laid out. The new policy has been presented to all staff and students and aims to create a positive culture that promotes excellent behaviour, ensuring that pupils have the opportunity to learn, and staff to teach, in a calm, safe and supportive environment.

Ofsted

Fearnhill is rated Good by Oftsed, with the school being judged to be 'Good' in all categories in our most recent assessment in September 2022.
