Dear parents/carers

End of Spring Term Arrangements

As we approach the end of term, I would like to share some notices regarding the end of term. School will finish early on **Friday 4th April at 1:00pm**. At the request of students this will be a non-uniform day; students must wear appropriate clothing. Students who need supervision can stay in school until the usual time. Those entitled to free school meals may stay for lunch if they wish. Lessons will run as normal for periods 1-3, followed by an end-of-term celebration during period 4.

After Easter, **students may wear summer uniform**. This means polo shirts are allowed, and ties are not required.

We will also be **raising expectations for uniform** to ensure all students are dressed appropriately. At the start of term our focus will be:

- **Only black shoes** are allowed – no trainers, even those with logos (e.g. Nike Air Force).
- **No leggings** are permitted.
- **Skirts must be an appropriate length,**
- **Shirts/polo shirts** must be tucked in.

If a student's uniform does not meet these expectations, they will be given three options:

1. Correct the issue immediately.
2. Borrow uniform from the school.
3. Go home to change.

If none of these options are accepted, the student will not be allowed into lessons until the issue is resolved. Persistent uniform issues, such as untucked shirts or rolled-up skirts, will result in detentions.

Finally, I would like to wish everyone a restful break. A reminder that **Year 11 & 13 Easter revision sessions** will be running during the holidays (details [here](#)), and the **summer term starts on Tuesday 22nd April**.
