Medic Mentor Work Experience - Emergency Medicine

This will give you a broad overview of healthcare from the medical, surgical and general practice perspectives, and will demonstrate the breadth of specialties offered within a medical career. Each session will also focus on the different skills,

values and quality of care domains required by a doctor, knowledge of which is essential to demonstrate throughout your application, in both your personal statement and in your interview. The programme has been designed as a spiral curriculum where each week you will acquire new knowledge, as well as building on what you have learnt from the previous sessions, all to help maximise and consolidate your learning.
